Deacon Ron's 40-Day Advent Prayer Challenge - Nov 15th - Dec 24th

Items Needed: - 1 Deck of Cards (with 2 Jokers)

Step-by-Step Card Setup (40 Total Cards)

Step 1: Remove and Discard Unused Cards

- Remove the Jack, Queen, and King of **Clubs, Spades, and Diamonds** (9 cards total).
- Remove one of the two Jokers (1 card).
- Set these 10 cards aside—they are not used in the challenge.

Step 2: Set aside the Cards that will symbolize the Holy Family and Thanksgiving Day

- Hold the Jack, Queen, and King of Hearts and the remaining one Joker to the side.
 - o (These 4 cards will be added back into the deck later.)

Step 3: Discard the Extra Cards

- Shuffle the remaining cards and remove the first 4 cards from the top of the deck.
 Set these 4 cards aside—they are not used in the challenge.
- (This step leaves exactly 36 cards to be used as the body of the challenge.)

Step 4: Insert the Joker (Day 13)

- Keep the main pile of 36 cards faced down.
- Without looking at any of the cards, place the reserved **Joker** in the deck after the first **12** cards.
 - o The Joker will be the **13th card** in the pile.
 - This will represent Thanksgiving Day (November 27th). a day off from fasting but a day to Pray a prayer of Thanksgiving (your choice)

Step 5: Place the Final Cards Representing the Holy Family (Days 38-40)

- Place the Jack, Queen, and King of Hearts at the bottom of the deck in this order:
 - Jack of Hearts (Joseph Day 38)
 - Queen of Hearts (Mary Day 39)
 - King of Hearts (Our Lord Jesus Christ Day 40)

Step 5: Begin your 40 Day Advent Prayer Challenge (Saturday, Nov 15th)

 Pick one card from the top of the deck each day to reveal your daily Advent Prayer Challenge. (if you already pray the rosary add this challenge on top of your daily rosary)

Value of Cards:

- Number Cards (2-10): Value shown on the card = Number of Hail Mary's to be said.
- Ace: Rosary of the Day (or Divine Mercy Chaplet if you already pray a daily rosary)
